



WGUTENNESSEE.

Memorandum of Understanding between Cleveland State Community College and WGUTennessee

The purpose of this agreement is to facilitate coordination and transfer of Cleveland State Community College (CISCC) graduates or staff to programs offered by WGUTennessee.

WGUTennessee will:

- Offer a five percent (5%) tuition discount to CISCC graduates and staff who enroll at WGUTennessee.
- Accept CISCC credits that transfer to a WGUTennessee bachelor's degree program, as outlined in Attachment A for education, business, nursing, and information technology and, provide a listing of courses required at WGUTennessee to complete a bachelor's degree.
- Offer WGUTennessee scholarships for which graduates and staff of CISCC are eligible to apply. The scholarship link is http://tennessee.wgu.edu/tuition_financial_aid/scholarships.
- Participate in transfer events and other related activities hosted by CISCC at no charge to CISCC.
- Make onsite visits to CISCC to share information/answer questions regarding WGUTennessee programs and policies.
- Promote reverse transfer agreements in order to: 1) increase associate degree completion rates for Tennessee community colleges, and, 2) award an associate degree to students who satisfy their TN community college degree requirements while enrolled in a bachelor's degree program at WGUTennessee.

CISCC will:

- Maintain a link between the CISCC and the WGUTennessee landing page for CISCC graduates and staff.
- Maintain current brochures describing WGUTennessee degree programs and services in counseling/transfer offices. WGUTennessee will provide these materials at no charge.
- Include information about WGUTennessee programs and services in communications sent to impending graduates and prospective transfer students.

General Provisions:

Termination

This MOU may be cancelled or modified by either party with a 30 day notice. Cancellation will not limit the benefits of this agreement for any CISCC graduates or staff who are enrolled in good standing at WGUTennessee or in the enrollment process.

Tennessee Claims Commission

Any and all claims against the State of Tennessee, including CISCC, or their employees, shall be heard and determined by the Tennessee Claims Commission in the manner prescribed by law. Damages recoverable against the State shall be expressly limited to claims paid by the Claims Commission pursuant to T.C.A. §9-8-301 et seq.

Other

This agreement may be reviewed, amended, updated and/or expanded by mutual consent of both CISCC and WGUTennessee. Any revisions will be made in writing and reviewed by each institution's respective Chief Academic Officer or their designee.

Appendix A shall be attached to this agreement. Appendix A shall include articulation/transfer tables for all related degree programs offered by CISCC and WGUTennessee. The tables will show all of the courses and credits transferred to WGUTennessee by graduates of related degree programs seeking admission to WGUTennessee.
